The InterfaCE** of Art and Science**

Science and art may suffer from academic division, but both sides of
the human brain are involved in creative processes. For over 20
years, biologist Sam Browser has worked with artists, writers,
musicians, and filmmakers while conducting research on and under
Antarctic ice. His presentation will focus on several art/science
projects, and discuss practical aspects of art/science collaboration.
