Bio. Dr. Eric Lifshin is currently a professor in the College of Nanoscale Science and Engineering at the University of Albany. Previously, he was at General Electric Corporate Research and Development where he managed the Characterization and Environmental Technology Laboratory and performed research in x-ray microanalysis and scanning electron microscopy. Eric has over 75 publications and 7 patents and has either edited or coauthored a number of books including the popular "Scanning Electron Microscopy", Goldstein, et. al. He also taught scanning electron microscopy courses at Lehigh for many years and has given many invited lectures at various conferences. Eric is a past president of MAS and has received the award for outstanding scientific contributions given by that society.
